

THE ANCIENT CITY GAME FISH ASSOCIATION 2021 Ladies Tournament

DATES: 1 May through 31 May 2021

FISHING: This "angler" tournament is for <u>all ACGFA lady anglers including Junior and Small-Fry</u>, Anglers can compete against each other while fishing on the same boat. Anglers must fish in local waters. Federal, State, and/or County fishing laws and regulations always apply.

<u>SAFETY:</u> SAFETY IS ALWAYS FIRST. Captains are responsible for the safe and legal operation of their boats at all times.

QUALIFYING FISH: Fish that are eligible for this tournament are all Inshore and Offshore fish listed on the ACGFA Year-end Board. Fish must be caught on hook and line, and landed in whole condition; as always, state bag and possession limits apply. The club minimum weight limits do NOT apply.

<u>RADIO</u>: Captains are reminded that they should have an operational VHF radio on board their boat for safety. Many ACGFA members monitor VHF channel 68, or channel 72

WEIGH IN: Ladies can weigh their fish at any club approved location. "Date and Time" on the weigh card should reflect the actual time the fish is weighed. Anglers are responsible for preparing ACGFA Fish Entry Forms correctly and for mailing them on time. In order for fish to count in this tournament, each card must be plainly marked "LADIES TOURNAMENT" in the "Tournament" blank. Entry Forms must be postmarked no later than seven calendar days after the fish is weighed, and mailed to ACGFA, P.O. Box 2001, St. Augustine, FL 32085-2001. Weigh in cards may also be submitted online via ACGFA.com fish card entry system.

AWARDS: 100 points will be awarded for the heaviest fish; 75 points for the second, 50 points for third and 25 points for fourth in each category. The point system will decide the top three lady anglers who will be awarded certificates and \$300 as follows: 1st place \$150 - 2nd place \$100 - 3rd place \$50. Time of earliest weigh-in will decide the winner of a tie. Awards will be presented at the club's Membership Party in June.

ENTRY FEE: Anglers must be registered on the website no later than April 30th at 11:59pm. Entry fee is free for members. There is a ten-angler minimum for this tournament.
