

Red Snapper Tournament Outline & Rules:

- This is a boat tournament.
- Entry fee is \$200 or \$100 if registered for Kingfish Challenge.
- This is a single heaviest fish tournament.
- Boats are limited to weigh in one fish per day with the exception of a Lady or Junior Angler single fish entry.
- Boats can have as many Junior or Lady Anglers as they wish. Each of those Anglers will be allowed to weigh 1 fish per day in addition to the fish the boat weighs. However, that fish may also be the boat's fish if a Lady or Junior Angler caught it.
- The tournament will run on July 10 - 11, 2021.
- Registration will be held on Friday, July 9, 2021 at Northeast Florida Marlin Club at Camachee Cove Marina from 4-7pm.
- No boat can enter the Atlantic Ocean prior to 5:00am. Lines in at 7am.
- All boats must leave from Fernandina, Mayport, St. Augustine or Ponce Inlet. Tournament fishing boundaries: North boundary is 31 line to the South boundary, 29 line.
- Weigh-in will only be at Camachee Cove Yacht Harbor, Northeast Florida Marlin Association Clubhouse. Weigh in times are 3:00 p.m. till 5:00 p.m. on Saturday and 2:00 p.m. till 4:00 p.m. on Sunday. Anglers MUST be in the weigh-in line by 5pm Saturday and 4pm on Sunday to be eligible to weigh in.
- You can bring your catch by boat or vehicle.
- Fish must be weighed on the day caught to be eligible.
- In case of tied weights, the winner will be determined by the earliest weigh-in slip number.
- Angler or Captain must finalize entry weight with signature directly after announcement of weight.
- Entrants assume all risk involved with the tournament.
- All anglers must have appropriate state licenses.
- Captains and crews are responsible for following all Federal, State, and local fishing and boating laws. Any boat receiving a citation from a law enforcement agency will be disqualified from the tournament. All anglers on the boat must have a valid Florida fishing license.
- No boats are to come together, unless an emergency exists. No boat may make landfall; or receive or pass anything to or from land.
- Any protest must be made in writing within 24 hours from when the potential issue occurred and be accompanied by a \$200 cash deposit. If

protest is upheld, the deposit will be refunded. If the protest proves invalid, the deposit will be forfeited.

- Decision of the weigh master is final. Violation of tournament rules will subject the vessel, captain, and/or angler to disqualification. In the event of disqualification, tournament entry fees will be forfeited.
- Any or all prize winners and contestants may be subject to polygraph test. In the case of a failed polygraph test, participants will be disqualified from the tournament.
- All rules are subject to change and will be announced prior to registration deadline.
- No refund of entry fees, unless the Tournament Committee cancels the Tournament. In that case, prorated entry fees will be returned after expenses.

Prizes/Awards:

- Cash prize will be 80% of collected entry fees. Winner takes all.
- There will be a designated item as the prize for heaviest lady and jr angler.
- Open TWT - \$50 (100%)
- NEFMA Members TWT - \$50 with \$500 added to pot by NEFMA (100%)
- ACGFA Members TWT - \$50 with \$300 added to pot by ACGFA (100%)
